COMMUNITY IMPACT

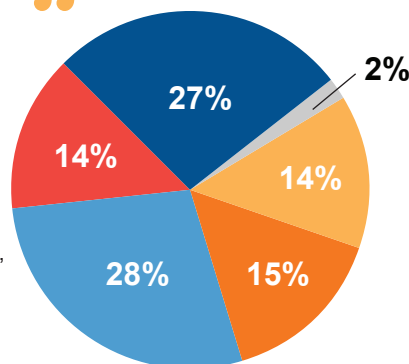
“Because of the generosity of our community, we have been able to give families double the amount of food we are typically able to give them. This means that families who have been financially impacted due to COVID-19 won't have to endure hunger as a product of that impact.”

“We were able to house men at a local hotel in Manitowoc for the quarantine period before they moved into the shelter.”

“A family of five came to our Community Dinners To Go, and the mom wept as she told us that if it was not for this meal and the Saturday food pickup, her family would not be able to eat. She and her husband were not working and unemployment had yet to produce any assistance.”

“One of the individuals we were able to serve through this funding was a pregnant individual who was living on the street when she contacted us. Although we knew she needed to get off the street, we could also tell over the phone that she was showing some of the signs of COVID-19. Because of these funds, we got her a cab ride to a hotel we were working with where she could quarantine before coming into the shelter so as not to put other guests at risk.”
